While reading the novel, please record 10 journal entries of at least ½ page each (handwritten).

What should you put in the journal entries? I want your *thoughts* and *reflections*, NOT a plot summary. I want you to *respond* to the characters, their actions and decisions, unfamiliar vocabulary terms, etc. If you need help, use the following questions, but don't feel like you are "bound" to them.

1. Discuss your reactions to what is happening in the book.
2. Describe what you have learned from the story.
3. Explain why you would or would not recommend this book to someone else.
4. Define any unknown vocabulary or terminology.
5. Does this book promote a secular or Christian worldview? Explain
6. Describe the main character(s).
7. Are you like any of the characters? Explain.
8. Has this book made you question anything about your life, future, relationships, etc?
9. Describe the setting of the story.
10. Describe a reoccurring theme of the book (a universal message)
11. Explain anything with which you disagree.

The books need to be read in their entirety and the journal and poster completed by Wednesday, August 18. In addition, we will spend about two days discussing the novel before being tested on the material.
